Dear Parents and families

We will begin Camp on June 29th, 2020. Please see below for updates/changes to our program, that reflects our directives from the State and Local Governments.

- 1 Temperatures will be taken at designated areas, as your camper is greeted.**
- 2 Parents will remain outside and your camper will be escorted by Camp Staff to their designated age group.
- 3 Please bring a back pack, which will remain onsite for the duration of your child's stay (-change of clothes, bathing suit, towel, sunscreen, and water bottle) We will transfer the wet items home at the end of the day, if they are worn.
- 4 Please hand the Medical Personnel, on site, your EPI-PENS, Inhalers, and documentation, upon arrival of your child. **General Health Forms are generated from your online registration.**
- 5 Groups will remain within their age demographic during the day. Activities for Kidde Camp and Main/Teen will be done in a variety of platforms:

Art, Science, Outdoor games/relays/water games/Gym time, World Traveler, Game Room, Newspaper ,Lunch, *The Art of being a CIT Clinic-NEW***

Rainy days at camp will still be permitted, as we utilize a large facility and **Social Distancing** is easily achieved. Should we hear otherwise from the Department Of Health, we will notify you of the change.

Lunch will be served in our Lunch Room. Campers will be seated and their lunch will be delivered to them. We will adhere to strict PPE for servers and food handlers, as we have done in the past.

In the event your child becomes ill we will notify you. If your camper presents with Covid like symptoms they must test negative for the illness before returning to camp

Minor scrapes, bumps etc. will be treated, as in the past by our Medical staff. We will note this and notify you. If a child presents with a temperature during the day, you will be notified and asked to get your camper.

Each child will be assigned their own set of art items, which will be labeled and kept in a zip lock bag, during camp. Tables, equipment, facilities, etc. will be cleaned throughout the day. Hand washing and hand sanitizing will also occur before and after activities.

If your child does not feel well, and will not attend camp, kindly notify the office. If at some point your child becomes ill with a communicable disease,(measles, mumps, chicken pox, Covid and the like) please notify the Camp Medical Director, as well.

Before and Aftercare will again, be available. Please fill out this spot on our website, in the registration portal. Hours Before Care 7:15 am, Aftercare ends at 5:45pm. Fee is \$8.00, prorated to the half hour.

** Fever is defined as 100.4 F
